Re:	2023 Brain Injury Program Standards Update

This Memo is to notify the Brain Injury Program service providers of policy/procedure changes for individuals enrolled in the Brain Injury Program. If you are an agency serving individuals enrolled in the Brain Injury Program, please implement the following procedures immediately:

Changes from Current Manual (dated 2016):

Reference Section V: Service Standards: page 36
 "Primary caregivers are expected to utilize two days of respite per month."

\*Change: Primary Caregivers are encouraged to use two days of respite per month.

Reference Section V: Service Standards: page 40
 "Standards: ...The chosen Provider Agency will develop an individualized budget utilizing the TBI All Inclusive Daily Rate Request Form located in Section IV."

\*Change: The TBI All Inclusive Daily Rate Request Form located in Section IV is replaced with the Individual Service Plan.

Reference Section V: Service Standards: page 30
 "Development, implementation, coordination and monitoring of comprehensive services provided to the individual as identified by the TBI Service Plan and the Care Plan.
 -Monitor the quality of care provided. Individualized program outcomes shall be evaluated quarterly utilizing the progress scale to complete the Rehabilitation Quarterly or Long Term Semi-Annual Evaluation.----"

\*Change: The Individual Service Plan and Rehabilitation Evaluation are submitted to the BIP coordinator for approval within 30 days upon admission, at 6 months and then annually from initial admission date or upon significant changes.
